Hay Lakes Playschool Mission Statement

Playschool Fees

Registration Fee - \$100 Recreation Fee - \$20 Janitorial Fee - \$120 Field Trip Fee - \$165 Monthly Fee - \$110

- The government of Alberta provides an affordability grant. Those who qualify will pay \$35, while the government will cover the other \$75. Fees can be paid monthly (with the exception of the fundraising, rec, and registration fees)
- Please note that if fees aren't paid, your child will not be able to attend.

Fees are payable by the 1st of each month (Sept-June) using e-transfer (treasurer.hlps@gmail.com, password: playschool) or cheque payable to Hay Lakes and District Playschool Society

We encourage families to apply for government grants for Child Care Subsidies.

Fundraising - \$300

- The fundraising deposit will be refunded to you once you have fundraised the minimal amount of \$300 (profit)

- Parent/quardian volunteers are needed to help with fundraisers. Will be discussed further during the AGM.

Class Time:

- 3-year-old class will be Mondays, Wednesdays, and scheduled Fridays.
- 4-year-old class will be Tuesdays, Thursdays, and scheduled Fridays
- Check in times between 8:15-8:30 am
- Pick-up time is 11:30 am
- PUF students: Monday-Thursday with scheduled Fridays

Sick Children Procedure (from the HLPS Parent Handbook)

Parents/guardians are asked to keep their child home if they have any of the following symptoms:

- fever
- diarrhea
- severe coughing
- difficult or rapid breathing
- yellowish skin or eyes
- pink eye
- head lice
- vomitina
- new or unexplained rash or cough
- requiring greater care and attention than can be provided without compromising the care of the other children in the program
- having or displaying any other illness or symptoms which may indicate that the child poses a health risk to others (ie covid)
